BUDGET - 2ND READING OF THE 2020-21 BUDGET

Mayor made a motion to accept the 2nd reading of the 2020-21 budget, Commissioner Dilbeck seconded the motion, all voted aye, motion passed.

STREET CLOSURES – CLOSURE OF HILL STREET AT MT. HARMONY
